

To: All the data subjects who have provided their personal data to Thai Secom Security Co., Ltd. prior to the enforcement of the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019)
Re: Method for the withdrawal of consent relating to the personal data which was collected prior to the enforcement of the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019)

Pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019) (“**PDPA**”) Section 95, Thai Secom Security Co., Ltd. (“**Company**”) hereby publicizes the method (“**Method**”) for the withdrawal of consent relating to the personal data which was collected prior to the enforcement of PDPA as follows.

1. The data subject (“**Data Subject**”) who has provided the Company with his/her personal data prior to the enforcement of PDPA may submit an application (“**Application**”) to the Company’s **Compliance Section**, HR department in the form prescribed by the Company.

3. The Company will, upon the receipt of the Application, review and check the identification of the Data Subject and his/her attorney (if any) and verify the ground of the application and the validity of the execution of the power of attorney.
4. The Company may request the Data Subject to provide any additional information or documents, etc. which are necessary to confirm the identification of the Data Subject and his/her attorney (if any) and validity of the execution of the power of attorney (if any).
5. The Company will consider the application submitted by the Data Subject, and if the Company considers that:
 - (1) there is no necessity and ground under PDPA for the Company to continue the collection and/or use of such personal data, the Company will erase and/or destroy such personal data; or
 - (2) there is necessity and ground under PDPA for the Company to continue the collection and/or use of such personal data, the Company may continue to collect and/or use such personal data to the extent permitted by PDPA and provided that the Company has complied with PDPA.

In any case, the Company will inform the Data Subject of the result of (1) or (2) above within thirty (30) days from the date which department name has received the application.

In case where there is any inquiry regarding the Method, the Data Subject may contact the Company’s department per the contact details above.
